 DTAG approved of Bethany Pluymers and Rob Kohlhepp being part of the DTAG Executive Committee.

#### <u>Endpoint Management & Security project update – Status Report 2018.07.18 (Bob Turner)</u>

- The July Status Report is currently going through the request and have received 25 inputs from vendors.
  - Next steps are to look at the vendors who meet the requirements and invite them in to start an RFP.
  - Communication with the other TAG groups on this Status Report will continue as the creation of the RFP.

# <u>Enterprise Communication and Collaboration (ECC) Team – Domain-based Message</u> Authentication Reporting & Conformance (DMARC) (Beth Wendt)

- Link to Presentation: <u>Domain-based Message Authentication</u>, <u>Reporting & Conformance</u> (DMARC)
  - Presentation will be presented at next ITAG and TLTAG
  - Presentation was to inform DTAG about DMARC
- DMARC policy enable email providers (like Gmail and others) to differentiate between valid (verified) email messages originating from the wisc.edu domain and SPAM or Phishing emails which imitate (spoof) UW-Madison email addresses.
  - DMARC is designed to protect against direct domain spoofing
- Who will be impacted by DMARC:
  - UW-Madison users who send email messages thru 3<sup>rd</sup> party mass email provides (e.g. MailChimp, Constant Contact, ect.) using a wisc.edu email address as the "From" address.
  - Non-UW-Madison email accounts which send as a wisc.edu email address (e.g. Gmail accont configured to send as a wisc.edu address).
  - Third-Party email scripts/servers that do not send email using on-campus mail services using a wisc.edu email address as the "From" address.

- Next Steps with DMARC:
  - Summer/Fall 2018 to Tag subjects of inbound mail that violates SPF or DMARC for @wisc.edu and to publish SPF all for wisc.edu.
  - Fall/Winter 2018 to publish 1% DMARC policy for wisc.edu, which could phase over in summer 2018 (optional)
  - o Spring 2019 to publish DMARC policy for wisc.edu.
