#### DoIT ADI Reorganization – System Services Group (Dave Pagenkopf)

- Mike Lehman wanted there to be a group that would focus on UW-System Application Support out of DoIT.
  - Some FTEs where already supporting UW-System.
  - Creating this group is to address financial issues and being able to prioritize the support the UW-Madison provides to UW-Systems.
    - 3 people from ADI has moved into this group.
  - Group was effective on April 30, 2018.
    - Chris Spencer will be acting as the Interim Cybersecurity Director of UW-Systems.

## Call for Vice Chair Nominations (Nicholas Tincher)

- Nicholas Tincher Chair end date is July 1<sup>st</sup> where Melissa Amos-Landgraf will take over as Chair.
- Call for Vice Chair nominations for next year.
  - Nominations for Vice Chair should be sent to Nicholas Tincher by noon on May 18, 2018.
  - Once nominations are collected, the DTAG Executive Committee will vote and agree on next Vice Chair.

## SIS Optimization (Scott Owczarek/Jeremy Traska)

- Upgrading to 9.2 PeopleSoft Campus Solutions and looking to optimizing SIS customization.
  - UW-Madison is currently in the 94 percentile for customization with Oracle.
  - Looking at communication about upgrade across campus.
- Currently, there is not a Cloud Solution that meet all UW-Madison business needs due to the amount of customizations.
  - $\circ$  The customizations/modifications take away the manual labor and process out of this.
- July 1-7, 2019 is when the updates will happen and systems may be down at this time, which will have impacts on campus.
  - August 7-11, 2019 is the backup date if July 1-7, 2019 does not work for upgrade.
  - By January of 2019 need to make sure there are financial resources available
  - Looking at having tool implementation integrations with other application by February.
    - Jeremy Traska is the main contact for this effort.
- Looking at having Governance behind the 9.2 Upgrade.
- DTAG agreed that they should be informed of the Upgrade to 9.2 progress.

#### Policy on Access to Student Data – Draft Policy (Scott Owczarek/Steve Devoti)

- Draft Policy focuses around Applications that need access to Student Data and making sure there are policies and procedures in place for Application to have access to the data.
- Next steps with Draft Policy is to socialize with other groups and ITAG.
  - Then to have this Policy go through the IT Project Intake Process.

# Updates from Rafi Lazimy (Rafi Lazimy)

- There is a need to look for a campus wide tool that will evaluate IT Assets on campus.
- Looking to start up the FY17 IT Spend Project sometime at the end of the month of May.
- The Policy Analysis Team (PAT) has approved of the Firewall Network Policy and a Cross-TAG Review Group has

been put together to review over policy.

 The Policy Analysis Team (PAT) is working on alignment of UW-Madison Cybersecurity Policies with UW-System's Policies.
