# 1. Automatic Consent Agenda

#### 2. CIO/COO Updates

- VOIP UC Update- Campus has made the decision to use Webex. The initial plan was VOIP only. Now a rollout of Webex will be accelerated.
- Update on WordPress/Drupal Centralized Service- the DoIT team will host Drupal. The cost is smaller than we hoped and will free up enough to fund both.
- Common Assessment- UW-Madison pays 40%, but only get 8% of the vote. The formula is weighted by the size of our staff combined with our students. UW-Madison should get a larger percent of the vote. We need more representation.
- Student Tech Fees- Provost Deluca wanted this brought back so we can do a breakdown to see what the money is being spent on. The commitment from Moodle will go away when we are fully moved to Canvas. Should that money go to Canvas?

# 3. IT Service Catalog Analysis Recommendation Paper

- The analysis was done by the cross TAG's. Can the analysis identify one to three opportunities for services that are scalable campus wide?
- Meloney reviewed the document with the committee.
- This is an opportunity to rethink how IT is paid for on campus. This recommendation will go to ITSC on April 21, 2017.
