2. ITAG Exec expressed approval to add a member of LTG (Library Technology Group). We feel a lot of what they do ties into our infrastructure group well.
3. Melissa and Steve will deliver a report from the Backup subgroup. A discussion needs to continue with what the ITAG feels should be the next steps.
