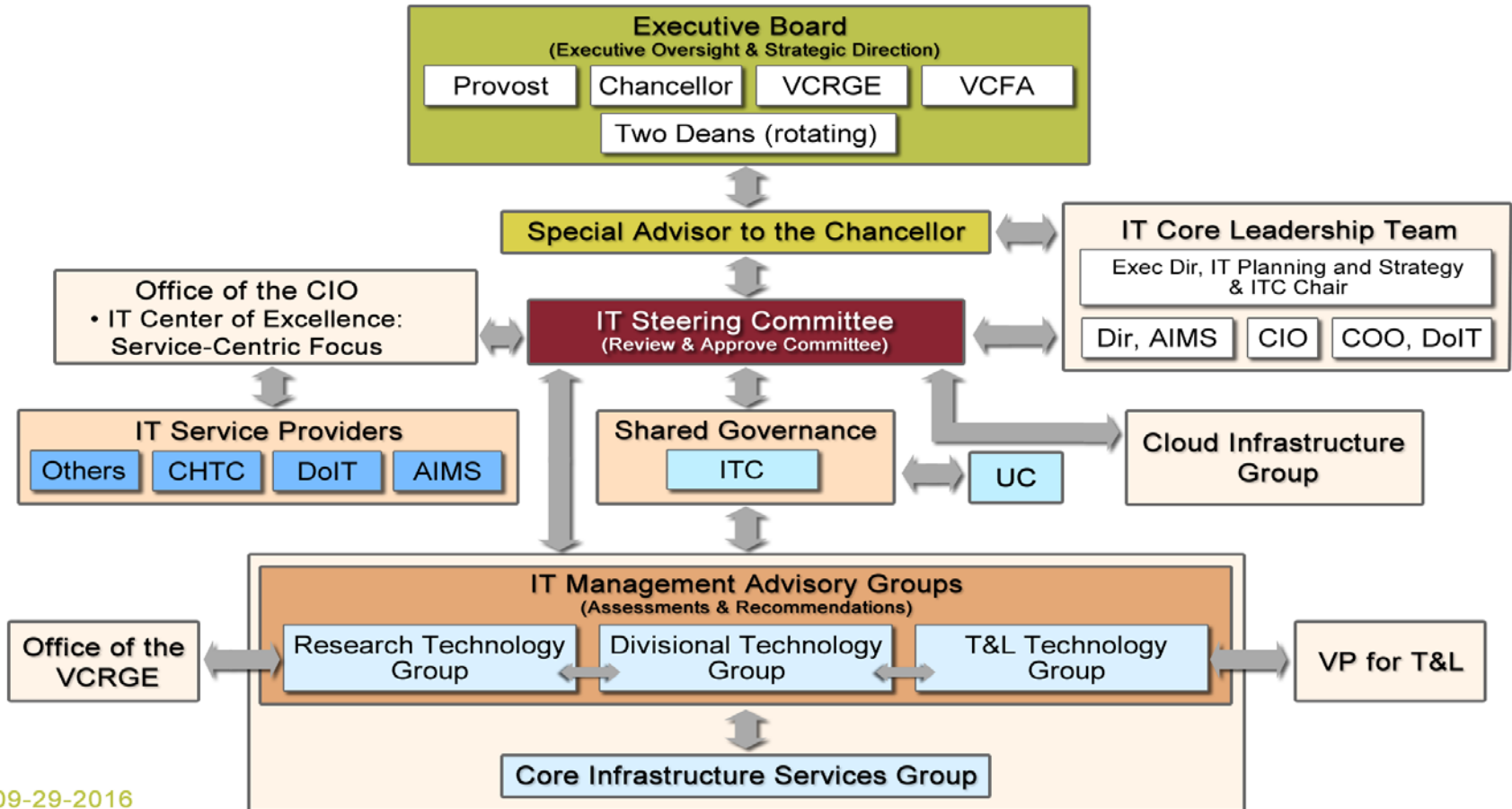

 4. New VCFA

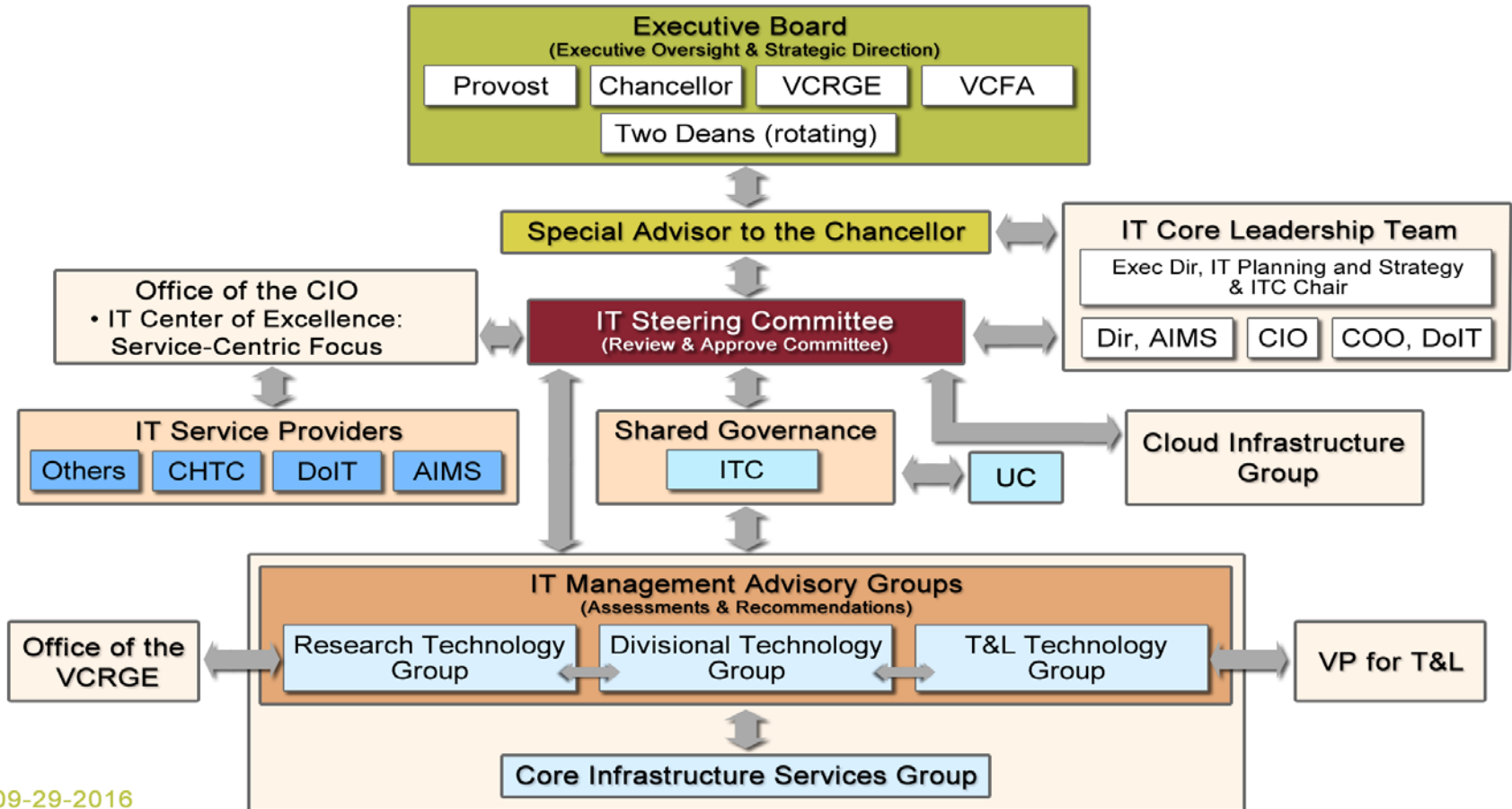

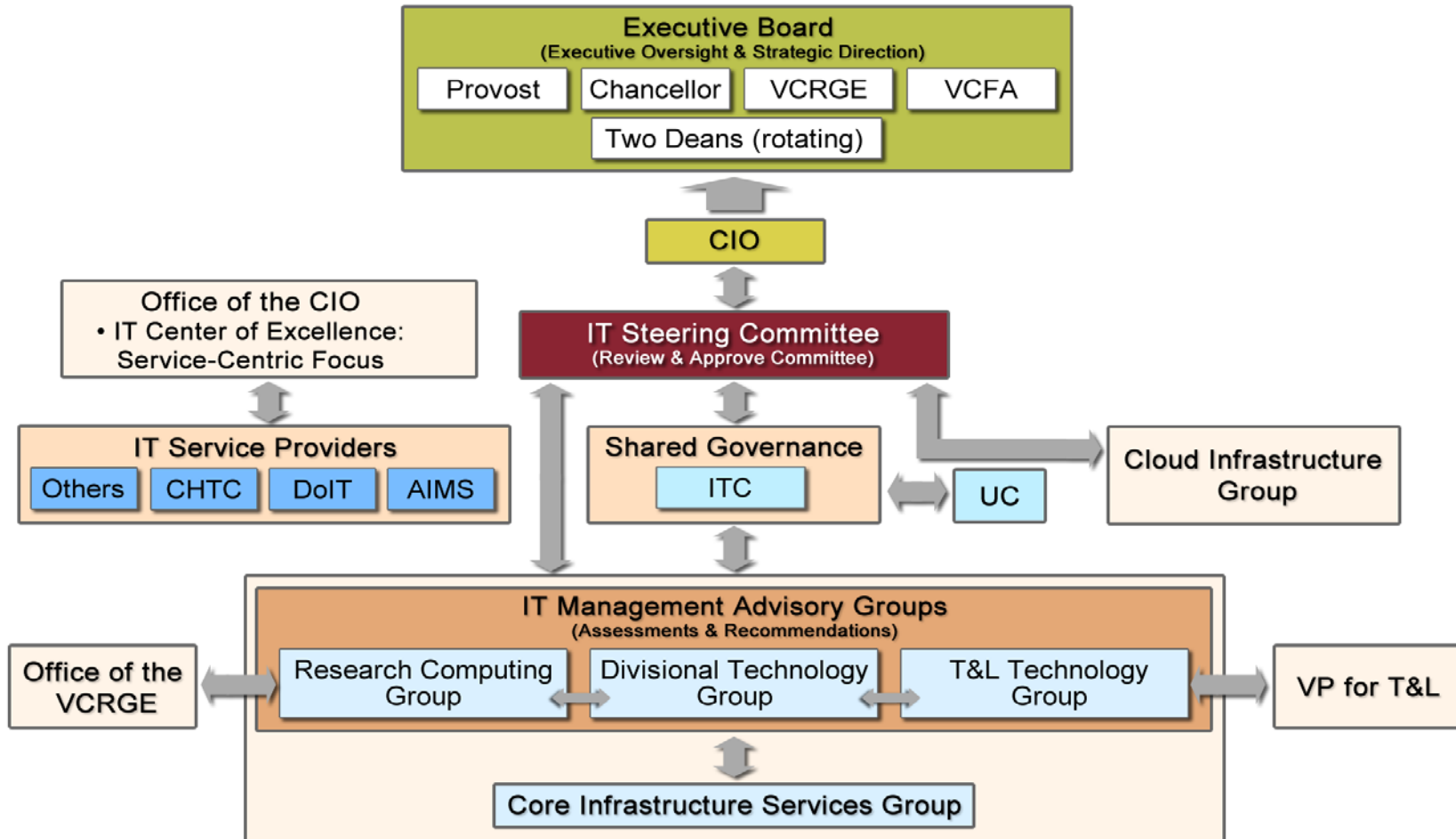
