Agenda Topic: Office of the CIO Updates (Rafi Lazimy)

- Policy Analysis Team (PAT) This is a subcommittee of ITC. They will review new and old IT policies. The main focus are policies that have significant IT components, services, or assets.
- Project Intake Prioritization- The team worked on this for many months. This is a great process for submitting IT Projects. This process started on October 1, 2017.
- IT Service Inventory- There are approx. 1500 services on campus. The data reorganization was done. The next step is rationalization.
- IT Spend- We want to create a consistent methodology that will be repeatable.
- Risk Management Policy- This was approved by all TAG's and will go to the University Committee in November. The implementation is still being worked on. The only part that was approved were the principles. There was some disagreement with this process. ACTION: Marsha would like to revisit this topic.
- The CIO and COO searches will begin soon.

Agenda Topic: UW-Madison Project Intake and Prioritization Process (Dawn McCauley)

- Dawn spoke about the 4 sessions that will be held to see an overview and how to submit a proposal. There are currently 4 projects moving through the que. The sessions will help you know and understand the process better.
- Most research projects do not fit this process. This will be avoided if people need to do this for every grant
 proposal. The website needs better communication. The committee was feeling misrepresented in the
 communication from the webpage. ACTION: The committee would like to re-visit this topic at the next
 meeting.
- RTAG will work with the project intake group to create an easier process.
