1. Intro/Welcome/General Announcements

- Minutes from the TLTAG meeting on February 15, 2019 were approved.

2. Discussion of Campus Instructional COOP (Steven Cramer)

- DRAFT for Academic Continuity Planning Scenarios
 - Creating a University of Wisconsin-Madison plan address classroom reassignments and class cancellations.
 - TLTAG suggest that someone from FP&M, Registrars Office, and DoIT Emergency should be involved with this campus plan.
 - LMS would like to be involved with this – Shirin Malekpour volunteered.
 - Kristopher Olds volunteered from TLTAG
- Issues that need to be addressed for this planning process:
 - Classrooms with Passcodes or keys for projections in classroom reassignments.
 - An understatement of phones or phone jacks in the classrooms.
 - Understatement of an instructor's needs in a classroom for a classroom reassignment.
- Understanding that the University holds a lot of financial risk if not able to deliver a course to a student.

3. Canvas Interoperability and 3rd Party Tools (Steve Cramer/Andy Goldstein/Bethany Gordy)

- Canvas Interoperability and 3rd Party Tools Presentation shared with TLAG.
 - Addresses integrations of 3rd party tools with Canvas used to enhance the digital learning environment.
 - Areas of consideration
 - Technical usage
 - Data Stewardship – Understanding how the data is being used and does not violates FIRBA.
 - Financial Constraints to campus and/or student.
 - Learning Experience – Students may feel that their learning experience is effected with too many tools.
 - Instructor Risk – Instructor's agreeing to Terms and Agreements without knowing the legal effects to what they are agreeing to.
 - Institutional Risk and Legal Issues (TLTAG Suggestion to add this)
 - Importance for instructors to understand how data is being handled by tools and the security around the vendor for handling student data.
- TLTAG suggested the idea of having a training for faculty members to understand how course tools could be using their students' data.

4. Kaltura Captioning Capabilities Updates (Andy Goldstein)

- Kaltura is a captioning of videos that AT is looking at doing a pilot on.
 - Provisionary issues with Kaltura wanting campus to deploy to all of campus instead of doing a small pilot on campus.
 - UW-System is looking to have UW-Madison validate user areas of usage and areas of deletion of unneeded space to keep cost of space down for licensing.
 - Communications will start with Faculty to understand the deletion areas.
 - Goal is to start a small pilot this summer for faculty to use.
